- Capacity building of victims support professionals workshops and training events in all the project countries















Guidelines for Victim Support Organizations



- Guidelines for Victim Support Organizations on how to support and provide support to children victims and witnesses of abuse and their families during the criminal procedures
- Practical approach, easy to be consulted including references for further readings
- Including additional practical information for each country involved in the project (i.e. helplines, dedicated emergency numbers, authorities in charge of different tasks as e.g. investigations)
- Target: victim referral and support services and organizations
- Language of the guidelines: English, and all the project languages
- Format: electronic

















Capacity building of victims support professionals - 1



- Local/national capacity building events (workshops) with victim support professionals in their respective countries - feedback from participants will be collected in order to apply corrections and improvements to the training material, but also to assess the impact of the trainings on participants (knowledge change)
- Based on the ENCLAVE Guidelines for Victim Support Organizations
- Target: victim support professionals, services and organizations
- Language: Local languages

The workshops in a nutshell - 1

- ITALY: organized by EuroCrime in cooperation with the Psicologia in Tribunale (Psychology in Court) web portal (https://psicologiaintribunale.it/) Italian network of Forensic Psychology and victim support professionals, addressing also lawyers, magistrates, police officers Two workshops of three hours each organized on line (7th October and 3rd December 2022) TOTAL of 207 participants
- **SPAIN:** organized by UC₃M– First workshop organized on the 5th of December 2022 in cooperation with the Madrid Bar Association, with a 78 participants Involving different speakers addressing in depth the different topics FORTHCOMING, on the 16th of January 2023 at the Centro de Estudio Juridico blended format (40 participants on line, 40 participants in presence) both workshops have a duration of three hours















The workshops in a nutshell - 2



- GREECE: organized in December 2022 by UWAH and UoC, online

 3 workshops (12th, 16th, and 19th December), with a total of 122
 participants very promising interest of the involved professionals
- **BELGIUM**: organized by KUL on the 13th December 2022, online
- ESTONIA: organized in presence on the 30 June 2022, with a total of 22 participants















Conclusions





- Multidisciplinary approach is increasingly relevant
- Recognized need for interdisciplinary training, involving professionals with different background and a different role in criminal proceedings but all involved in forensic interviews with children
- Fundamental role of the ENCLAVE Training Guidelines for Victim Support Professionals in providing support and in raising awareness regarding the different criticalities
- ENCLAVE capacity building is still ongoing!
