



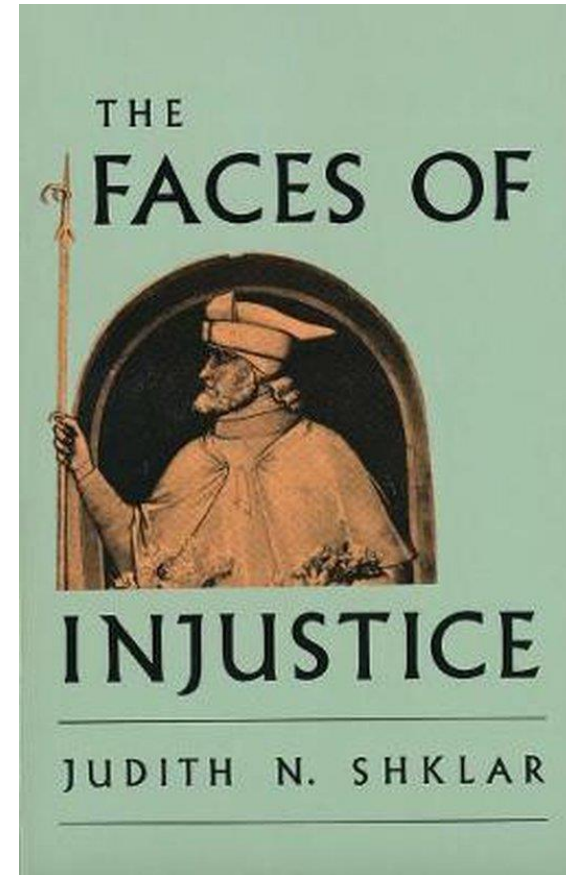
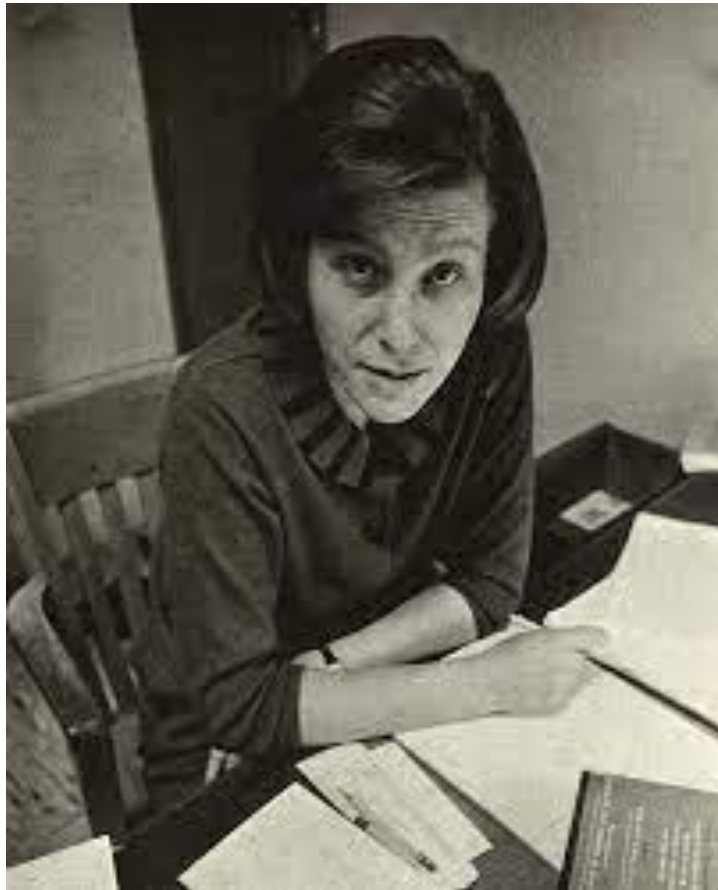

Shklar in the Faces of Injustice

The importance of understanding “injustice as a phenomenon in its own right”

Not only as an absence, transgression or an opposite of justice

Countering the injustice of experiences of victims does not always cohere with the requirements of “doing justice”

Remain aware of the tension



Connection to the experience of child victims

Countering injustice: how best to meet the needs for support, protection and participation of child victims?

Doing justice: in what way can evidence be secured, what are the requirements of the investigation of the case, how to secure due process?

It will often be perfectly feasible to meet both aims at the same time, but sometimes there will be unavoidable tensions. What then?

In my view this underlies some of the main issues in project ENCLAVE, looking forward to discussing this with you today.
