- WP4 focused on victim support professionals and organizations
- Three main tasks:
- Development of database of relevant victim support organizations Including data regarding all relevant Victim Support Organizations in the project countries, in English and in all the project languages, fully searchable and available on line
- 2. Development of guidelines for victim support organizations Drafted by WSIC in tight cooperation with all the partners, translated in all the project languages
- Capacity building of victims support professionals workshops and training events in all the project countries















Capacity building of victims support professionals - 1



- Local/national capacity building events (workshops) with victim support professionals in their respective countries - feedback from participants will be collected in order to apply corrections and improvements to the training material, but also to assess the impact of the trainings on participants (knowledge change)
- Based on the ENCLAVE Guidelines for Victim Support Organizations
- Target: victim support professionals, services and organizations
- Language: Local languages





















- Free Final Webinar, engaging victims support organizations across Europe
- BUT: recognized need for multidisciplinary approach & involvement of professional with a different background but interested/involved as well in the forensic interviews with children victims or witnesses of violence
- LIVING PROJECT = inclusive, multidisciplinary event
- Target: victim support professionals, services and organizations a
- Language: English

















Conclusions





- Multidisciplinary approach is increasingly relevant
- Recognized need for interdisciplinary training, involving professionals with different background and a different role in criminal proceedings but all involved in forensic interviews with children
- Fundamental role of the ENCLAVE Training Guidelines for Victim Support Professionals in providing support and in raising awareness regarding the different criticalities
- ENCLAVE capacity building is still ongoing!
